This season, the Point Loma High School Baseball Field on the campus of Dana Middle School will be re-named David Wells Field. David Wells was a Pointer from 1978 through 1982 and went on to a successful 20-year career in Major League Baseball where he played for many teams including the San Diego Padres, Toronto Blue Jays and the New York Yankees. David pitched a "Perfect Game" while with the Yankees, one of only 18 ever to be pitched in the major leagues. Notably, another of those rare perfect games was pitched by Don Larsen, PLHS Class of 1947. History takes time, and now the time has come to recognize this strong tradition of baseball excellence at Point Loma High School.
