Century Open Golf Tickets—Coach P will be giving the athletes 100 tickets to the golf tournament at Torrey Pines. Coach P thinks he can raise \$1,700 and expects to give the Boosters \$700. He would like the Boosters to coordinate the sale of the tickets.

3 games at USD the weekend of 1/16 to 1/18/2010—the 1/18 game against Cathedral Catholic was cancelled due to USD covering the field in preparation for strong rain. Coach P says Coach Johnson (USD Baseball Coach) will try to make up the game against Cathedral Catholic.

The game on 1/23 may be cancelled depending on the condition of the baseball field at Dana Middle School.

The Baseball Clinic will be moved to 1/31/2010 due to the condition of the field.
